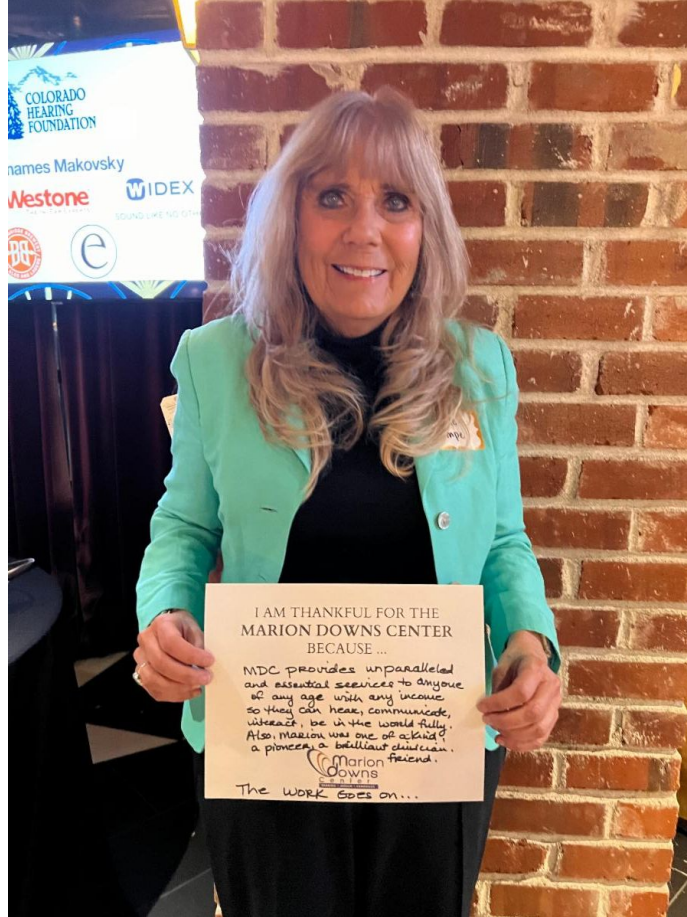

COMMUNICATION STRATEGIES DURING THE HOLIDAYS



As the holidays approach, family and friend gatherings become more common. Individuals with hearing challenges may struggle in noisy situations or overlapping conversations. Consider these strategies to improve communication.

Get people's attention first.
Turn background volume down.
Take turns talking in groups.
Keep areas well-lit.

It's always ideal to ask deaf and hard of hearing individuals their preferences for communication and accessibility.

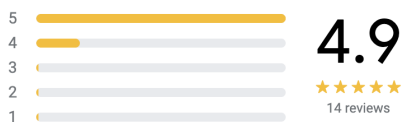
