Mandatory Statewide Mask Order




Executive Order D 2020 138 is a mandatory statewide mask order in effect for 30 days from July 16, 2020 and will be extended by Governor Polis.

This executive order requires people in Colorado who are 11 years and older to cover their nose and mouth when entering or moving within any public indoor space or while using or waiting to use public or non-personal transportation services. <u>Learn more about Executive Order D 2020 138 here.</u>

Executive Order D 2020 138 also includes an amendment that includes an exemption for people with hearing loss engaged in communication.
